	Practice your number bonds to 10 and 20 by playing the Hit the Button Games 'Make 10' or 'Make 20': <a href="https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button">https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button</a>
	Get someone in your family to say a number between 1 and 30, can you tell them 1 more and 1 less? 10 more, 10 less? Can you write out some to share with the class?
	Year 1: Practise counting in 2s and 10s. Can you share it with the whole class for a house point? Year 2: Go to Gig Mode on Times Table Rock Stars and see how you get on.
	Write a story about your favourite animal. Could they come to school? Or go on a wild adventure? What if you met a lion?
	Write a poem about your pet.
	Make a poster about saving our wildlife. What should people do to help? How can we make sure we're all doing our bit? Best posters might even be shown to the whole school!
	Create your own animal dance. Can you move like a tiger, flamingo or lemur? Why not watch videos closely to see how they move exactly. You could be one animal or lots!
	Paint a picture of an animal in their natural habitat.
