

## **PARENTS' WEEKLY CHECKLIST SEPTEMBER 2020**

### **P.E. Wednesdays and Fridays.**

Please ensure PE bags are brought in on Mondays. They will be sent home on Fridays for washing. We will *a/ways* be doing PE outside. As the weather gets colder, please provide your child with a fleece/sweatshirt and warm jogging bottoms.

### **Jewellery**

No jewellery is allowed in school except for watches. For safety reasons, ear-rings are not allowed to be worn during P.E. If any children have had their ears pierced, **ear-rings *MUST* be removed *AT HOME*** on PE days, or children can remove ear-rings themselves. We are ***not allowed*** to remove them or cover them with plasters.

### **Water bottles**

We have provided all the children with their own labelled water bottle. These are stored in class and children will be instructed in how to use them safely and hygienically. Please ensure all water bottles are washed each weekend and returned to school (**already filled**) on Mondays.

### **Show and Tell**

Show and Tell will be rather different at the moment, as we are unable to allow items such as toys to be brought in and out of school. However, we will still have 'News Time', where children verbally share their news with their friends!

### **Forest Schools Thursday afternoons**

Please ensure your child has a pair of wellies for Forest Schools. These can be brought into school in a named plastic bag and stored on your child's peg. In order to minimise the amount of equipment/clothing we store in the cloakroom, and to enable ease of cleaning, we are unable to keep wellies in the cloakroom permanently. They will need to be taken home each Thursday. We will endeavour to let you know if we are not running Forest Schools at any point.

### **Reading Books**

Reading will be taught and practised in school on a regular basis, through Guided Reading and Phonics sessions. We are presently looking into ways in which reading books can be sent home and returned to school in a 'Covid safe' manner. I will inform you when staff have had these conversations and reached a decision.
