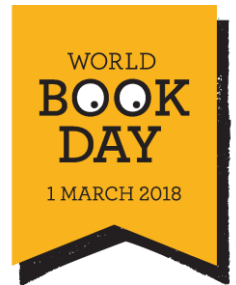

Children can either:

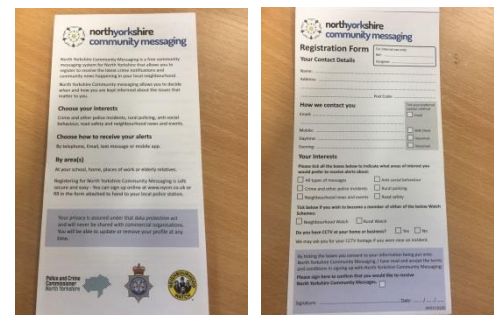
- bring an object/prop/clue from their favourite book, or

New Community Defibrillator



The defibrillator is now in place at Dunnington Primary School and is registered with North Yorkshire Ambulance Service. This is a vital resource to support the community and first responders. The defibrillator is situated on the boiler house wall facing Pear Tree Lane and is accessible via the pedestrian gate at all times. To make use of this life-saving piece of equipment, phone 999 and you will be instructed how to open the cabinet. In conjunction with Essential First Aid Services we have organised some training for the community – details below.

Learn lifesaving skills

This course is designed to give you confidence in CPR and how to use the AED machine.

What Will You Learn?

Basic lifesaving skills.
Confidence to deal with a first aid situation where CPR and the AED may be required.

- AED – how to use a defib machine
