


TOAST AND MILK PAYMENTS

Dear Parents

Our Reception/Key Stage 1 topic for this first half term is 'Ourselves'. As part of this, we are reading the story 'Wilfrid Gordon McDonald Partridge' to see how special memories can be. In the story, a memory box helps older people to remember things they did or enjoyed in their younger days.

We would like your child to bring in to school something that acts as a trigger for a memory for them.
