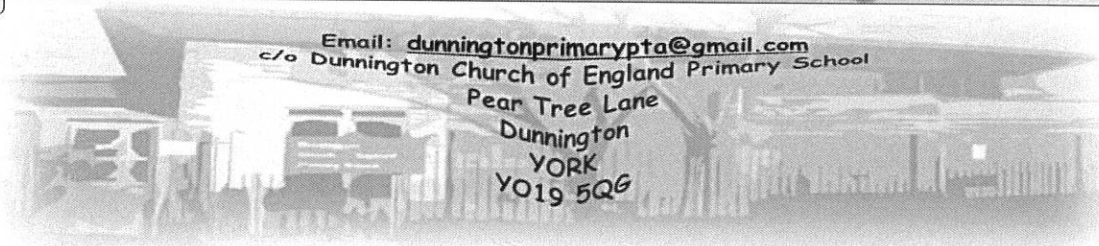

The bag contained a Dunnington School sweatshirt size 7/8, a pair of PE shoes size 12 and a t shirt age 5/6.

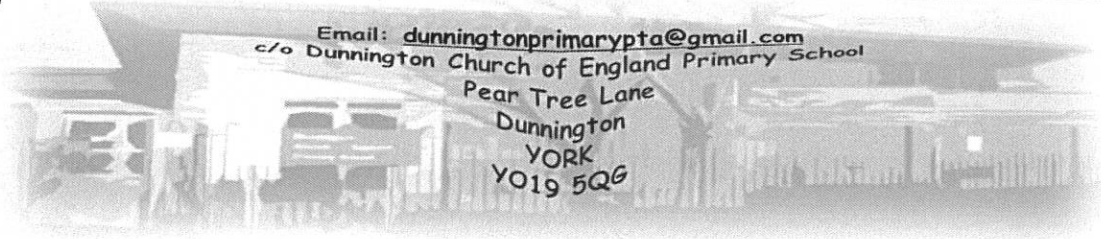
If you think this bag belongs to your child please call the school office who have contact details for the lady who has the bag at her home and is keen to reunite it with its owner.

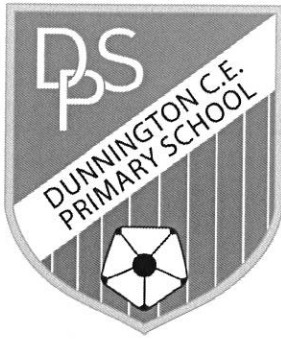

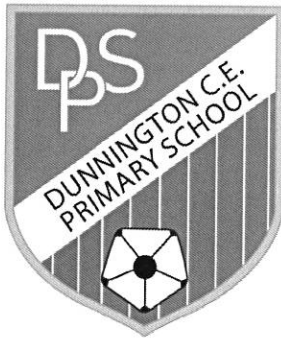

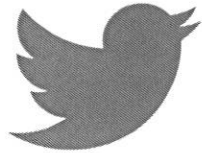
