Dear Parent / Carer,

I am writing to inform you about the Year 5 residential trip to Low Mill Outdoor Activity Centre in the village of Askrigg. The dates for the trip are Wednesday 8th to Friday 10th May and as these dates have been reserved, I am now keen to confirm the number of children wishing to go on the trip as soon as possible.

The activities will be spread over three days and will hopefully include abseiling, caving, gorge walking and canoeing. Although some of these activities may seem a little daunting at first, all the children (and indeed teachers) on past visits have taken part and found them incredibly rewarding. We have all gained in confidence and returned to school with a real sense of achievement. In addition to this, it is ideal preparation for the longer residential visit which takes place in Year 6.

You will be informed of the finer details such as necessary clothing nearer the time. In the meantime, if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to visit www.lowmill.com or speak to myself.

The total cost of the visit this year is £175. This amount includes the activities, coach travel, meals, 2 nights of accommodation and the use of the centre's minibuses. Parents in receipt of certain benefits may be entitled to a reduced fee - please call in for a confidential chat with either the office or Mrs Hancy. The balance can also be made in instalments over time if you prefer. This year, there will also be the added benefit of being able to pay using Parentpay.
