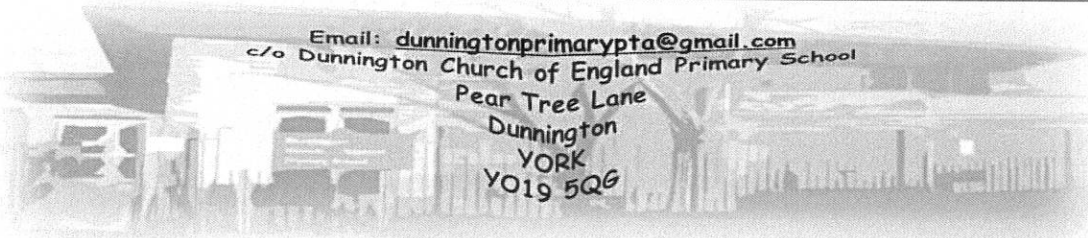

One final mention must be given to a fantastic 15m throw of the javelin by Ben Rees Gay...a formidable distance for a child in Year 2!



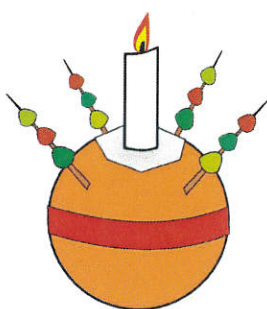
