

KS1 Enrichment Activities

Topic: 'All Things Bright and Beautiful'

Activities I have chosen	Homework Activity Choices
	<p>Year 1: Create a game that helps you practice counting up in 2s 5s and 10s. If you're really confident you could even challenge yourself to count up in 3s.</p> <p>Year 2: Don't forget to practise times table rock stars.</p>
	Write down a normal day in your life. The challenge is to write down what time you do things and for how long. (e.g Wake up 7:00 am. Brush my teeth 7:15 for 2 mins ect...) You could even include pictures or photos if you like.
	<p>Year 2: Create your own Bar chart or Tally chart that shows what is your families and friends favourite pet or food.</p> <p>Year 1: Practise money on this game: https://www.topmarks.co.uk/money/toy-shop-money</p>
	Can you write a story about a sculpture that came to life. Use your imagination and have fun with it.
	Poem of the day. Read a poetry book. Pick your favourite poem to share with the class. Practise performing your poem at home using a clear, loud voice. Can you explain why you like the poem? (If you can find any with a plant or sculpture theme that would be great!)
	Can you write a poem about Spring. Try to use lots of description about flowers, weather ect...
	Draw a spring flower from your garden and label any parts you may know..
	Go on a Spring walk and collect different items to remind you of what you have seen along the way. Then try to draw a landmark map of where you have been. (just need pictures and arrows)
	Can you draw the flags of the countries in the UK. You could also search for and then add information about each country.
