5. Draw an upside-down self-portrait using crayons
6. Unveil a new handshake
7. Make something spin for the longest period of time
8. Make the best paper aeroplane. Furthest flight wins
9. Make the most impressive throw of something, into something
10. Stand up for 100 seconds - exactly!
11. Make an adult say 'bubbles'. You cannot use the word 'bubbles'
12. Make an adult laugh out loud. You must not touch them
13. Stage a performance of a nursery rhyme
14. Wear the most unusual hat
15. Put on five layers of clothes
