We would like you to have a go at representing this on a drawing of a tree. The different parts of the tree will represent parts of your journey so far. Have a look at the picture below for the instructions. Have fun! Be creative and when you have finished post a photo on Seesaw for your teachers to see.

On the leaves write all your hopes and dreams for the future. Maybe the things like your first residential trip, going to secondary school, maybe college or university, getting a job, or maybe travelling the world!



On the trunk write all the things you have achieved so far. You can start with things you learnt to do as a baby like walking or talking, then maybe starting nursery or school and include something you learnt to do for the first time like ride a scooter or a bike. Mark on the trunk where you think you are now in your journey.

On the roots write the people and groups that give you strength, keep you safe and inspire you. This could be family members, teachers, sports coaches, a club you are in etc.
