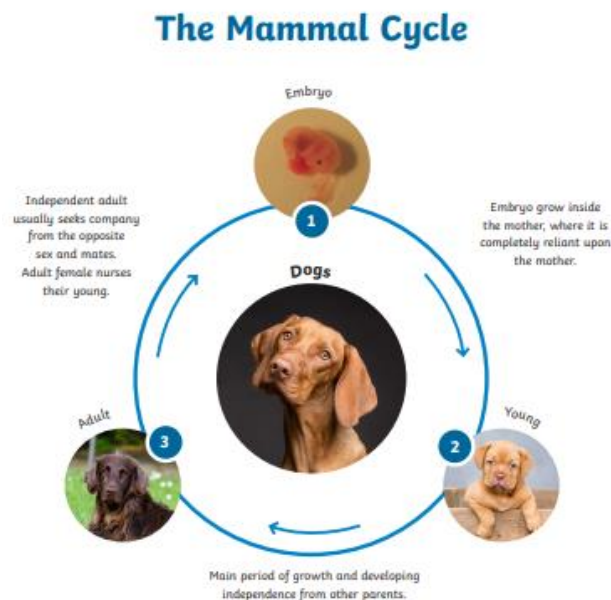


Year 5 - Science w/b 27/04/20 & 04/05/20
