## What Do You See?

### SHAPES

concentric circles  
geometric  
organic  
overlapping

### LINES

straight  
curved  
zig zag  
wavy  
horizontal  
vertical  
diagonal

### COLOURS

complementary  
analogous  
hues of one colour

## Materials




coloured markers  
paint pens (not essential)  
cartridge paper ~ 30cm x 30cm  
lead pencil  
ruler  
eraser




collection of  
bowls/plates  
of varying  
diameter

Begin by placing some bowls on the paper and tracing around them. Place smaller bowls inside the circles you've drawn.



Overlap the circles. Use your ruler to draw some straight lines. Experiment with creating different effects. Keep looking back at Beatriz Milhazes work to get some ideas.



Erase some of your lines so that you have rings and shapes that look like they're on top of others. Draw some lines inside some shapes.



Choose areas to colour  
with complementary  
colours.

Choose areas to colour  
with hues of one colour.



Be patient!  
Take your time.  
Outline each area before  
colouring it in.

Colour carefully in one direction.  
Think about your colour choices.
