### Getting here

Creswell Crags is situated on the north Derbyshire/Nottinghamshire border.

### By car

**From the A60:** four miles south of Worksop. **From the M1:** four miles east of Junction 30 signposted to Worksop. **From the A616:** take the B6042, signposted to Creswell Crags.

### By train

The site is approximately 15 minutes walk from the Robin Hood Line station in Creswell village.

### By bus

The 77 service between Worksop and Chesterfield and the 33 service between Worksop and Mansfield stop in Creswell village, about 1 mile from the museum. The 757 express service between Nottingham and Doncaster stops on the A60 about 1 mile from the museum.

 November–January ..... Weekends only
