Our topic this term is living things and their habitats. Over the last 2 weeks you have researched the lifecycles of a mammal, an insect, an amphibian and a bird. If you haven't quite finished yet don't worry but you will need that information to do this week's task.

Your task for this week is to compare those 4 lifecycles and look for 1) similarities and 2) differences. You can record the information how you like, possibly as a table like below, but you may have an idea of your own! We have started you off with some ideas in the table below:

Similarities between lifecycles	Differences between lifecycles
All of the lifecycles show being born, growing up into young and then into adult.	The lifecycles show that some lay eggs but some give birth to live young - such as mammals.
