

## Year 5 Home Learning – English for week beginning 18.05.20

### Reading

1. (From last week) Over the next week, concentrate on reading as regularly as possible. Maybe there is a book you've been wanting to read, or wanting to finish? Then, write a Bookflix review. You can find the review document on the website.

### Writing

1. There is a grammar activity to complete on the use of standard English. A Powerpoint is available in PDF form to help. You will have touched on this in Year 3/4, and may find you actually 'just know' a lot of it already!
2. Last week you might have written your first newspaper report on a positive news story. This week you will write a second newspaper report. Consider, how could you improve your writing from your last piece? Maybe ask a family member for some feedback on your work. Your newspaper reports will need to be planned, drafted and edited. You might want to then publish them on a computer, or hand write them afterwards! Here is your second journalist assignment:

Write a newspaper article based on something which has happened in Brazil. You can invent facts if needed, as it doesn't have to necessarily be a real event. Here are some suggestions you can choose from:

Deforestation or forest fires in the rainforest	A new species of animal has been discovered	Brazil have been victorious in a sporting event
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### Spelling

1. Please follow the spelling rules as usual. It is recommended that you practise the words most days, to make up the school spelling sessions you would usually have. You can find the spelling list for Summer 1 on the Year 5 homework page with the others. There are also some activities on the website you might want to complete to help with practising your spellings.
2. Please ensure that you **test** yourself on your spellings on Friday. You will need an adult's help to come up with some appropriate sentences containing all the words, and then to read the sentences out to you as you write them down. Inventing the sentences yourself will be a useful activity!
