left?



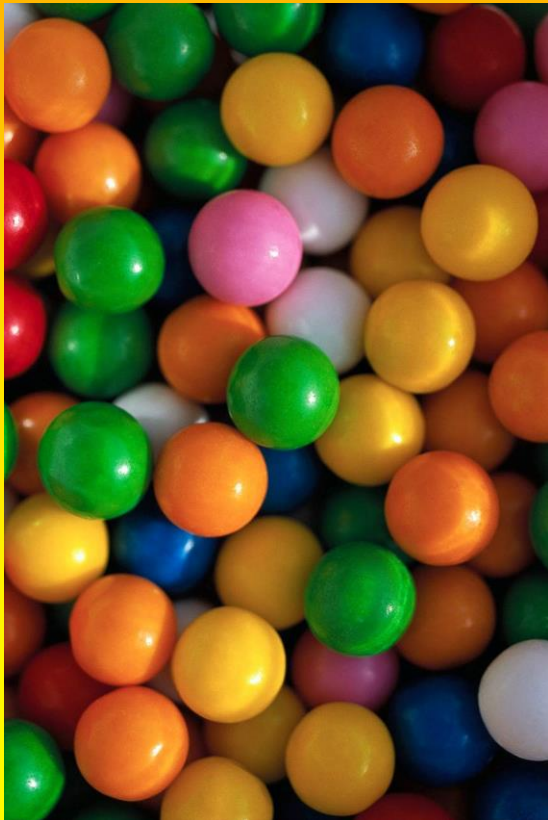
There are 29 children in the café.
