

## Year 5 Home Learning – English for week beginning 29.06.20

*I know that English, particularly writing, can be challenging for children at home. ### **Reading**

### **Writing**

**For writing this week there is a choice of different activities. You can choose to complete one, several, or all of them.**

**Choice 1:** There is a **BBC Bitesize** task to work through linked to brackets. You might want to create your own comic after using the comic frames on the school website.

**Choice 3: Grammar activities.** On the website are a bank of SPAG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) resources and activities to work through. These can be completed at your own speed over multiple weeks.

### **Spelling**

1. Our spellings now are reviewing the Year 5/6 word list. You will find there are a few more spellings each week, but that we have covered most of them already this year. This can be found on the usual homework page with all the rest of this year's spellings.
