Find out their ages and try some of these challenges:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put the numbers in order • Add the numbers together • Who is the oldest/ youngest? • How old will they be in 10 years time? <p>How many of your own challenges can you come up with?</p>
	<p>Design and make your own Maths game to help you learn your number bonds to 10 or 20 or 2x, 5x, 10x, 3x tables.</p>
	<p>Play on some games from www.ictgames.co.uk</p>
	<p>Set yourself a sporting challenge (running, jumping, skipping, hopping). How many times can you do this in one minute? Can you beat your personal best?</p>
	<p>Create a personal or a family time line asking your parents and grandparents to add in significant dates. (e.g. birth dates, marriage dates, significant events)</p>
	<p>Create a portrait of a family member in the media of your choice. Write a caption underneath.</p>
	<p>Write your perfect menu for a family meal. Compare this with a parent or grandparent by getting them to write their favourite family meal from their childhood.</p>
	<p>Make a list or draw some objects in your bedroom and write some labels for these. Use your phonics to help you spell the words correctly. Challenge: Can you write a sentence about your favourite object using the word 'because' to explain why it is your favourite?</p>
	<p>Review a book that you have recently, and give reasons why you would recommend it to a friend.</p>
