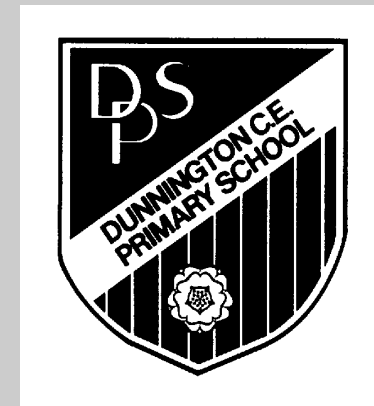
- ✓ Do my best to arrive at school on time, prepared and equipped for lessons
