Heartache & Inspiration

OSCAR's Paediatric Brain Tumour Charity (PBTC) was formed in 2014 by the parents and friends of Oscar Hughes, a 9-year-old boy from York who died of a brain tumour.

Oscar was sporty and energetic when first diagnosed, but his journey to be free of cancer was both heart-breaking and inspiring to see. The treatments involved have devastating effects on a young body and mind.

The charity aims to provide Ongoing Support, Care, Awareness and Research (OSCAR), giving support and care to children facing brain tumours, increasing awareness of symptoms to aid diagnosis and funding the latest research to improve treatment.



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
