Dear Parents/Carers,

Autumn Term Parent Consultation

Parent consultations will be scheduled for the week commencing 17th October 2022. This is an important opportunity for you to discuss how your child has settled into their new class and their progress in school.

Appointments will be held virtually using the School Cloud platform. We have found this to be a time efficient way of conducting our consultations. The platform provides an easy to use online appointment booking system, allowing you to choose your own appointment times with teachers. The booking system will go 'live' on Monday 10th October 2022 at 4pm.

Teachers will identify sufficient slots to see all parents/carers on the following evenings:

Reception	Tuesday 18 th and Wednesday 19 th October 2022
Y1/2 DA/LR	Tuesday 18 th and Wednesday 19 th October 2022
Y1/2 KP	Tuesday 18 th and Wednesday 19 th October 2022
Y3/4 JD	Tuesday 18 th and Wednesday 19 th October 2022
Y3/4 SJ/CT	Wednesday 19 th and Thursday 20 th October 2022
Y5 LS	Wednesday 19 th and Thursday 20 th October 2022
Y6 RD	Wednesday 19 th and Thursday 20 th October 2022

Once a parent books a slot, that slot then becomes unavailable to other parents. Once booked, appointments will be confirmed via email.

The parents' evening itself will be hosted via video call allowing you to speak to your child's teacher from the comfort of your own home. No app is required to be installed, you can just use a smart phone or laptop. All calls are encrypted. The video call finishes at the end of the appointment time (10-minute allocation) and automatically moves to the next person in the schedule.

In order to make video calls you need to have as a minimum:

- a device with a microphone and speaker/headphones
- a compatible up-to-date web browser:

iPhone/iPad: Safari, Chrome



Android: Chrome, Firefox or the Samsung Browser

Windows: Chrome, Firefox or Microsoft Edge (Chromium - download here)

Mac: Safari, Chrome or Firefox Linux: Chrome or Firefox


We also recommend:

 Using your smartphone for video appointments. If you don't have a smartphone with a front-facing camera, use a laptop or computer with a webcam.

Using a headset (or earphones with a microphone) to reduce echo.

KS2 Musical Opportunity

We've teamed up with York Music Forum to start a brand-new musical activity at Dunnington C.E. Primary after Autumn Half Term... the **pBuzz Band**! A pBuzz is a colourful plastic wind instrument that is so much fun to play and can lead on to playing any brass instrument. YMF will lend your child a pBuzz to bring home and practice. pBuzz Band sessions will be on Thursdays immediately after school for children in **KS2** and only cost **£5** per session. Once your child has got to grips with playing a pBuzz there will an opportunity to move on to 1-2-1 brass instrument tuition. pBuzz Band sessions will be led by YMF Director, Ian Chalk, who you might know as the trumpet player in York-based party band 'HUGE'.
