The board generally meet once each half-term (sometimes a little less) in a friendly and creative group, with one shared objective: the best outcome for our setting. (The current trustees have all had/have children that attend the setting.) We can be flexible on dates/times and have generally held the meetings via Zoom since the pandemic.

As well as the privilege of gaining valuable insight into the organisation of the setting, trustees get the opportunity to apply their own qualities and life skills to the creative development and practical problem solving required in its management.
