## World Book Day- Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2023

Thank you for all your support and efforts with World Book Day. There were some fantastic cakes produced and the children enjoyed sharing and, on the whole, exchanging books with friends! The School Council managed to raise a massive £166 from the bake sale so thank you for supporting them with this. The winning entry from each year





group was presented with a £5 book token in assembly this morning and the proceeds of the bake sale will go towards new books for the library.

A few KS1 children brought in a book to swap but then became upset with the thought of having to give it away and wanted to take their own book back home. Therefore, we took the decision in KS1 to keep all the swap books in class to read together and share the stories that way. We will do this over the course of the next few weeks and then return the books back to the original child.

Children are currently busy writing their class story books. If you would like the opportunity to buy a hard copy of the class storybooks, printed by Potato

Print, then all the information is included on the flyer which was sent home last week. Hard copies of the books will be available for £4.99, digital copies for £3.99 and there is a special pre-order price of £5.99 for a printed and digital bundle.

### **Mental Health Workshops**

I am pleased to inform you that, in the coming weeks, our school is taking part in a research development project in partnership with Hoglets and York Theatre Royal. Children in Reception through to Year 4 will take part in a series of workshops using varying art forms (drama, storytelling, puppetry, music and movement) to explore and ascertain their understanding of emotions, physicality/body language and mental well-being. This research project will inform the script development for a production called 'The Girl Who Stole Smiles'. Eventually we hope for the cast to return to school to perform the show to our children.

#### **Spring Term Parent Consultation**

Parent consultations will be scheduled for the week commencing 20<sup>th</sup> March 2023. This is an important opportunity for you to discuss how your child's progress in school.

Appointments will be held virtually using the School Cloud platform. We have found this to be a time efficient way of conducting our consultations. The platform provides an easy to use online appointment booking system, allowing you to choose your own appointment times with teachers. The booking system will go 'live' on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2023 at 4pm.

Once a parent books a slot, that slot then becomes unavailable to other parents. Once booked, appointments will be confirmed via email.



The parents' evening itself will be hosted via video call allowing you to speak to your child's teacher from the comfort of your own home. No app is required to be installed, you can just use a smart phone or laptop. All calls are encrypted. The video call finishes at the end of the appointment time (10-minute allocation) and automatically moves to the next person in the schedule.

#### In order to make video calls you need to have as a minimum:

a device with a microphone and speaker/headphones

• a compatible up-to-date web browser:

iPhone/iPad: Safari, Chrome

Android: Chrome, Firefox or the Samsung Browser

Windows: Chrome, Firefox or Microsoft Edge (Chromium - download here)

Mac: Safari, Chrome or Firefox Linux: Chrome or Firefox

#### We also recommend:

• Using your smartphone for video appointments. If you don't have a smartphone with a front-facing camera, use a laptop or computer with a webcam.

Using a headset (or earphones with a microphone) to reduce echo.


