Rearranged Spring Term Parent Consultation for Y3/4 CT/SJ

The parent consultations for Mrs Todd and Mrs Jones' class have been rescheduled for Wednesday 24th and Thursday 25th May 2023. This is an important opportunity for you to discuss how your child's progress in school.

Appointments will be held virtually using the School Cloud platform. The booking system will go 'live' on Friday 28th April 2023 at 4pm.

Teachers have identified sufficient slots to see all parents/carers on these evenings. Once a parent books a slot, that slot then becomes unavailable to other parents. Once booked, appointments will be confirmed via email.

The parents' evening itself will be hosted via video call allowing you to speak to your child's teacher from the comfort of your own home. No app is required to be installed, you can just use a smart phone or laptop. All calls are encrypted. The video call finishes at the end of the appointment time (10-minute allocation) and automatically moves to the next person in the schedule.

In order to make video calls you need to have as a minimum:

- a device with a microphone and speaker/headphones
- a compatible up-to-date web browser:

iPhone/iPad: Safari, Chrome

Android: Chrome, Firefox or the Samsung Browser

Windows: Chrome, Firefox or Microsoft Edge (Chromium - download here)

Mac: Safari, Chrome or Firefox Linux: Chrome or Firefox

We also recommend:

- Using your smartphone for video appointments. If you don't have a smartphone with a front-facing camera, use a laptop or computer with a webcam.
- Using a headset (or earphones with a microphone) to reduce echo.


