PUNCTUALITY

A polite reminder of the school start times for each key stage. We have a number of children, particularly in key stage two, who are regularly arriving late to school.

Children in KS2 should arrive at school between 8:40 and 8:45am, no earlier as staff cannot be available for supervision. Registration times are detailed above.

If children arrive during registration but before 9:15am, they are marked as late. **The registers close at 9:15am**, therefore, if a child arrives after this time, they will be recorded as 'late after the register has closed' which shows as an **unauthorised absence** in the overall attendance figures.

Persistent lateness causes problems for the child, the class and the teacher. Parents should therefore try to ensure that their child arrives in time for the start of school.

BROWNLEE MINI-TRIATHLON

I just want to say a huge thank you to all the children who took part in the Mini Brownlee Triathlon on Wednesday at York Sport. The weather was kind to us and the sun shone brightly...perfect conditions to experience what it feels like to undertake a triathlon...on a much smaller scale!

48 children from KS2 took part from Dunnington but over 1200 pupils from across the city were involved throughout the day. They started in the pool swimming 75m, went quickly to their own clothes basket and put on their t-shirt and trainers. A quick exit of the side door, whilst handing their basket to a member of pool staff and then onto 800m of biking round a slalom course on the grass. Once completed they ran 300m to a glorious cheer and a well-deserved goodie bag and a bottle of water.

All the children demonstrated great resilience and had huge smiles on their faces as they took part. They cheered each other on in between mouthfuls of popcorn, whilst recovering and were a pleasure to take out of school. There was roughly 8 minutes to get changed in our allotted time slot and the girls narrowly beat the boys! Many thanks to the parents who accompanied us to ensure things ran smoothly. I hope we might have a few keen future triathletes in the making after gaining an insight into this amazing event.
