We are so excited that, in a few weeks, Year 5 will be heading on their long-awaited residential trip! There are lots of brilliant activities planned for us there by Newby Wiske Hall, which I know the children will enjoy and find a valuable experience. Here are some last-minute details about our trip for you to note:

Kit List

PGL have provided a kit list for us, a copy of which I have attached to this letter. As stated previously, children should <u>not</u> bring any electronic devices with them, such as smart watches, Fitbits or mobile phones. They will, however, require a torch! Children will also need a packed lunch and a filled water bottle on Monday. Please note that our school still adheres to a no-nut policy on residential trips. The children do not need to bring sweets with them, but can purchase any from the gift shop if they so wish. Should your child require any medication, such as travel sickness pills, please deliver to a member of staff on Monday morning, in a clearly named bag.

Medical/Dietary Requirements

If your child will require any medication administering, either themselves or by an adult, please complete the attached medical form and return to school as soon as possible. Also, if your child has any <u>additional</u> dietary requirements, other than those already known about in school, please could you also complete the appropriate form attached.

Arrival and Departure

Children should arrive at normal school time on Monday 19th June, and bring their luggage round to the Year 5 classroom, which will have space for bags. Our coach is booked for 9:50 so there will be plenty of time to check any details and visit the toilet. No school uniform is required! We are departing Newby Wiske Hall on Wednesday 21st June at 13.00, which means our arrival time back at school will be approximately 14.30 (traffic dependant). As stated in a previous letter, Year 5 children should be collected from school **as normal** by a parent or guardian. If you need to inform me of any collection arrangements for your child, please notify the school office.
