Behaviour Policy

We have recently introduced a new behaviour policy and anti-bullying policy. I have attached the reward and sanction pyramids attached to this newsletter which summarise the rewards and sanctions we use here at school.

We hope we will be getting in touch with you far more often to share successes and things to celebrate. However, if your child gets to step 4 on the sanction pyramid (a time out with a member of SLT), we will log the incident on our internal systems and we will inform parents/carers. If a child has engaged in other unacceptable behaviours, such as hurting someone on purpose or swearing, they will be given an appropriate sanction, based on the age of the child and the severity of the incident, the incident will be logged and parents/carers will be informed.

Please do contact your child's class teacher(s) if you have any concerns about behaviour or anything else that may be affecting your child's attainment or wellbeing in school.

Illness

York Minster Christmas Tree Festival 2023

I know I saw a few parents on Saturday trying to hunt down the tree we have contributed to in York Minster.

York Music Hub's tree can be found within the stunning Chapter House of York Minster and will be situated there until the 5th January. On it, you will be able to scan our bauble and hear our rendition of It was on a Starry Night.

There are lots of wonderful trees included in the Christmas Tree Festival and the Minster looks even more stunning than ever at this time of year. It really is well worth a visit.

Headlice

We have had some reports of head lice in school. In order to reduce the spread we would appreciate if you could check your child's hair for head lice and eggs

Below is NHS guidance on wet combing hair to remove lice and nits:

Lice and nits can be removed by wet combing.

You can buy a special fine-toothed comb (detection comb) online or from pharmacies to remove head lice and nits.

There may be instructions on the pack, but usually you:

- wash hair with ordinary shampoo
- apply lots of conditioner (any conditioner will do)
- comb the whole head of hair, from the roots to the ends

It usually takes about 10 minutes to comb short hair, and 20 to 30 minutes for long, frizzy or curly hair.

Do wet combing on days 1, 5, 9 and 13 to catch any newly hatched head lice. Check again that everyone's hair is free of lice on day 17.
