## **Spring Term Parent Consultations**

We have scheduled parent consultations the 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> March. These consultations will provide you with the opportunity to discuss your child's academic progress and how you are able to support them at home.

Appointments will be held virtually using the School Cloud platform. We have found this to be the most time efficient way to conduct our consultations. We appreciate that some of you miss having the opportunity to come into the classroom which is why we held the open afternoon earlier in the term.

School Cloud provides an easy to use online appointment booking system which allows you to choose your own appointment time with teachers. The booking system will go 'live' on Monday  $4^{th}$  March at 6pm and will close on Sunday  $10^{th}$  March at 12 noon.

Once a slot is booked, it becomes unavailable to other parents and will be confirmed via email.

No app is required to be installed - you can just use a smart phone or laptop. All calls are encrypted. The video call finishes at the end of the appointment time (9 minute allocation).

In order to make video calls you need to have as a minimum:


- A device with a microphone and speaker/ headphones
- A compatible and up to date browser

We also recommend:

- Using your smartphone for video appointments. If you don't have a smartphone with a front-facing camera, use a laptop or computer with a webcam.
- Using a headset (or earphones with a microphone) to reduce echo.
