# Message from Mrs Thompson

## **School Uniform**

- a white polo shirt or school shirt
- a red or blue polo shirt embroidered with the school logo
- sensible shoes (not trainers)
- a summer dress (optional) in red or blue check/stripes

- Black Shorts
- White T- Shirt

There is no obligation for the jumper/ polo shirt your child wears to have the school logo on, but all of the children should be wearing uniform in the correct colours. Thank you for your support and understanding with this.

Please also make sure your child has a coat/ waterproof with them at school at all times to allow the children to get outside at playtime as often as possible. As we have seen over the last few days, the weather is very changeable and unpredictable at this time of year!
